National Taiwan Normal University Regulations for Tobacco Hazards Prevention

Approved at the 338th Administrative Council on November 28, 2012 Amended and approved at 373rd Administrative Council on October 13, 2021

- Article 1 The Regulations for Tobacco Hazards Prevention are established to protect the health of faculty, staff and students and promote a smoke-free campus. For matters not stipulated in these Regulations, the provisions of other laws and regulations shall apply.
- Article 2 Smoking, including electronic cigarettes and heat-not-burn products, and littering of cigarette butts are completely prohibited indoors and outdoors on University campus grounds.
- Article 3 The Office of General Affairs shall place conspicuous no-smoking signs at all entrances to the campuses and advise all shops on campus not to sell tobacco products.
- Article 4 All administrative and academic units shall join forces with the community, civic organizations, and student clubs to promote tobacco hazards prevention awareness and education through faculty and staff training, health education promotion, student club activities, classroom instruction, adviser hours and Chun-Hui Youth-Support Project activities.
- Article 5 The faculty, staff and students of the University have the obligation to discourage smokers on campus. Smokers who refuse to cooperate after being dissuaded may be reported. The identity of the person who made the report shall be kept confidential. Repeat offenders are reported to the local health authorities in accordance with the Tobacco Hazards Prevention Act.
- Article 6 When a student, staff or faculty member has the intention to quit smoking, the Health Center will provide counseling services, smoking cessation support or referral for treatment.
- Article 7 If any person, vendor, or visitor from outside the University is in violation of the regulations on smoking on campus in Article 2 herein, they shall be politely advised to stop smoking. If they fail to do so, they will be reported to the campus security, or a local health inspector may be notified to come to the University for investigation and management.
- Article 8 Persons who have contributed to the promotion of tobacco hazards prevention may be reviewed and rewarded. Those who have successfully quit smoking may be commended in public.
- Article 9 These Regulations and any amendments thereto shall become effective after approval by the Administrative Council and ratification by the University President.
